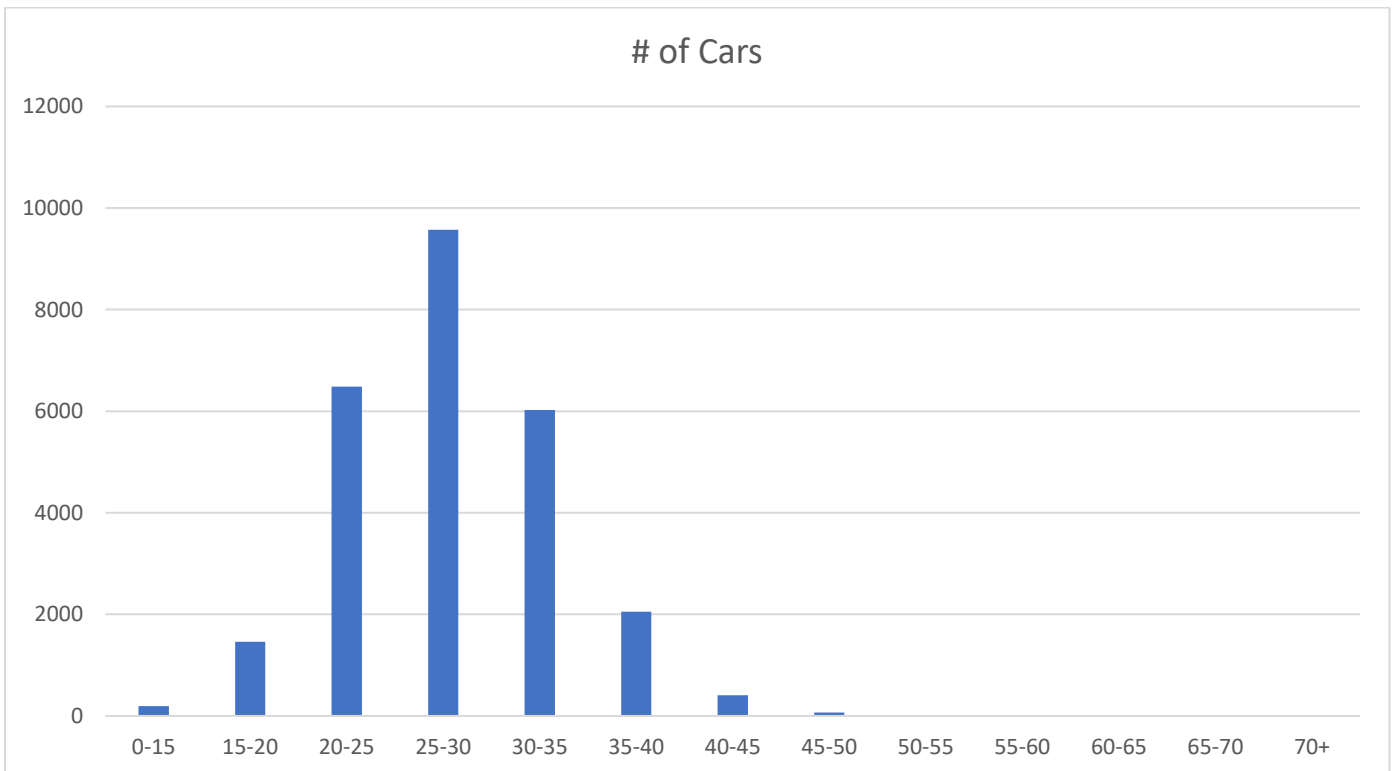
Summary

Hartwell Road, Little Ashton, still has a significant number of cars breaking the speed limit.

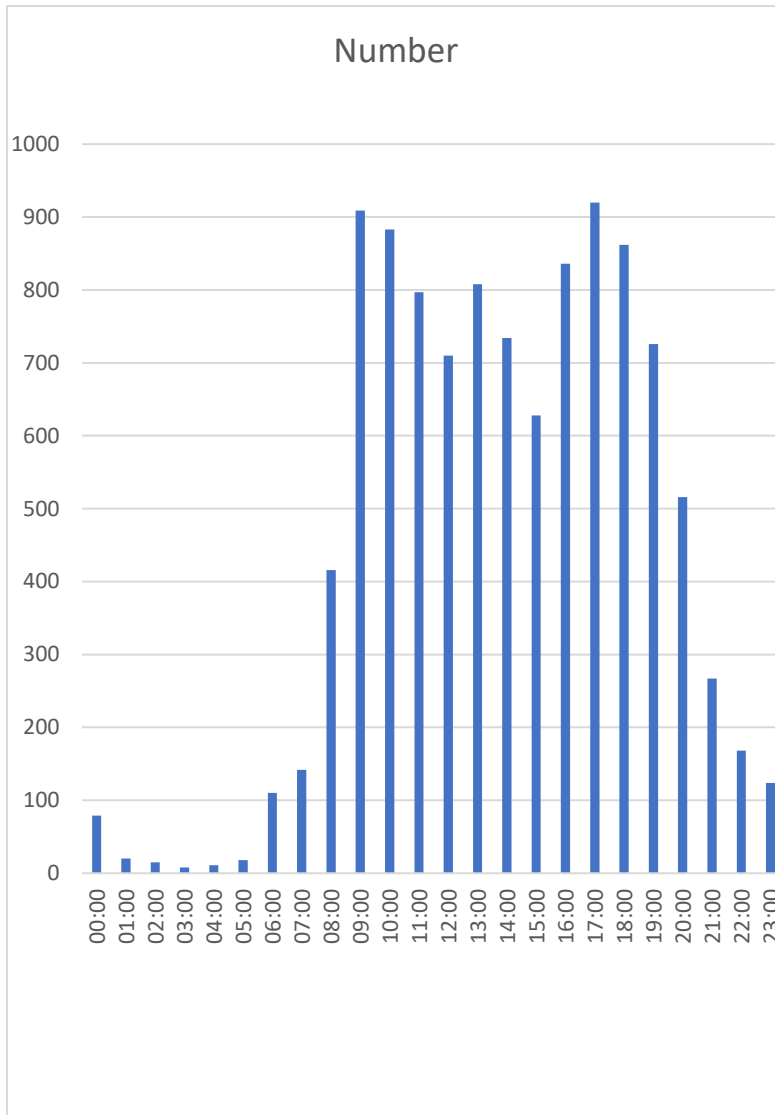

Speed Sign Locations

There are five speed sign locations. Each speed sign location is mounted on a lamp post. The lamppost location provides a power supply to the speed sign. This is backed up by internal rechargeable batteries.

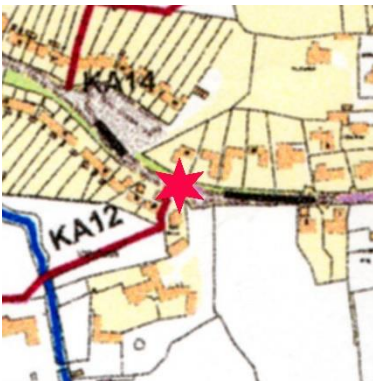
Location 1 Little Ashton facing NE out of village ; Lamp Post 19



Location 2 Corner of Bozenhamill Rd and Hartwell Rd facing NE out of Village; Lamp Post 15



Location 3 Stoke Rd entrance of Vale Farm facing West; Lamp Post 5



Location 4 Stoke Road near Rugby Club facing West: Lamp Post 1



Location 5 Top of Road hill near Hilltop facing North; Lamp Post 30
